## The elements of choosing policy instruments:

## **Agent characteristics**

- Behavioral assumptions:
  - The kind of rationality (rationalities) involved
  - Capacity to handle information
- Agent structures
  - Few many
  - Large small
  - Homogeneous heterogeneous

## The character of the institutional setting

- Rights structure
- Authority structure (local community national state international agreement)
- Distributional effects and norms of fairness/ acceptability

## The character of the environmental problem

- **Pollution** (public bad)
  - <u>type of emissions</u> (local global; homogeneous heterogeneous; one several types of emissions; 'point nonpoint')
  - type of damages (toxic non-toxic; accumulative non-accumulative)
- Public goods
  - **type of public good** (discrete or relational; simple or complex; homogeneous or heterogeneous)
- Cost structures (also depend on agents and system/institutional setting)
  - Environmental costs
  - Abatement costs (input substitution, changes in production technology, cleaning facilities)
  - Transaction costs
  - Precision
